On Wednesday 12th August it is the massive 999 day with displays from all our emergency services, the pet & dog show and much much more.

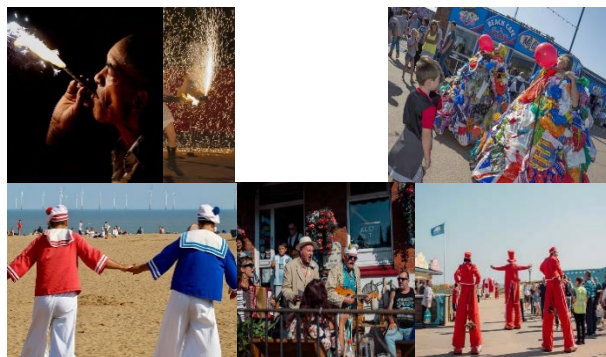


Skegness SO Festival
